

THE CITY OF OSNABRÜCK

Osnabrück is a beautiful, historic German town of about 170,000 inhabitants, including 28,000 students, with churches and half-timbered houses going back to medieval times. With theatres and museums, international events and traditional festivals, cinemas, bars, clubs and sport facilities it can boast a wide variety of cultural events and recreational facilities. Situated close to the Dutch border and between two mountain ranges, Osnabrück also offers beautiful scenery as well as easy access by train to the cosmopolitan cities of Hamburg, Amsterdam, Berlin and Cologne.

HOW TO GET TO OSNABRÜCK

You can reach Osnabrück by plane or train. There are connecting flights from all international airports in Germany (such as Hamburg, Frankfurt, Berlin, Munich) to Osnabrück (Flughafen Münster-Osnabrück) or you can take the train.

Speaking, reading and writing in German will be trained by working on a variety of up-to-date topics taken from society, economy, culture and technology. Project work in small groups (2–4 persons) supplements the language training at the higher language levels.
